EVERGREENS**(Bundles of 25 = \$16.50)**

Norway Spruce (Picea abies)**10-18"**

Fastest growing spruce. Short-needled tree with deep green color. Good Christmas tree, ornamental and reforestation use.

White Spruce (Picea glauca)**10-18"**

Very hardy, compact tree with short blue-green needles. Fast rate of growth for Christmas trees, ornamentals and windbreaks. Tolerates wide variety of soils.

White Pine (Pinus strobus)**8-12"**

Soft blue-green needles 3-5" long. Fast growth with excellent needle retention. Desirable for Christmas trees, ornamentals, and reforestation.

Douglas Fir (Pseudotsuga menziessi glauca)**10-18"**

Excellent demand as a Christmas tree or an ornamental. Extremely fast growth, superb needle retention and soft, 1" blue-green needles make Douglas the favorite tree for many growers. Prefers fertile, well-drained, light soil with full sun.

Colorado Blue Spruce (Picea Pungens glauca)**10-18"**

One of the finest trees for Christmas tree, ornamental and windbreak use. Color ranges from blue-green to silvery blue. Our seedlings are grown from the very finest seed collection areas available. This provides you with superb color, excellent shape and a good growth rate.

Victoria - Heirloom variety. Slender red/green stalks can be harvested after the first year. Excellent for cooking and baking.

TREES AND FLOWERING SHRUBS

Silky Dogwood (*Cornus amomum*) \$3.00 ea. 24-36"

Shrub from dogwood producing good wildlife cover and feed for birds. Berries produced are a pale blue with foliage turning a deep red in the Fall.

Pin Oak (*Quercus palustris*) \$3.00 ea. 24-36"

Native tree with fast growth to 75 feet in good soil. Fine textured leaves are deeply cut and assume a russet, brown or red autumn color. Leaves hang on longer than any other hardwood in the winter. The upper branches are upright, the middle branches are horizontal and the lower branches are pendulous, giving this tree a beautiful and graceful pyramidal outline. Acorns are good wildlife food. Good as a windbreak almost year around. Will tolerate wet soil but prefers moist rich, acidic, well-drained soil.

White Oak (*Quercus alba*) \$3.00 ea. 18-24"

Broad, round dense head, spreading branches and purple-red Fall color. Leaves remain on tree for Winter interest, bark light gray and flaked.

Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*) \$3.00ea. 18-24"

A Native of North America. Fast growing. Heights can reach 90 feet. Can live up to 500 years. Bark is dark reddish grey brown. Leaves are green in summer and a rich brownish red in fall. The acorns make good wildlife food.

Chinese Chestnut (*Castanea mollissima*) \$2.50ea. 12-18"

Grown in a nursery from seed of selected strain. Hardy, blight-resistant, fast growing tree which bears nuts slightly larger than the now extinct American Chestnut. Plant two or more for pollination. Height at maturity about 30-35 feet.

Sugar Maple (*Acer sacharum*) \$2.50 ea. 12-18"

Height 60 to 75 feet. Spread 45 to 50 feet. Mature trees provide sugar products from sap in the spring. Brilliant yellow, burnt orange and limited red tones in autumn. A good timber tree. Does not do well in wet areas or in small compact restricted growing areas. Native to northeastern United States.

Purple Lilac \$2.50 ea. 15-18"

This common lilac cultivar is an upright, deciduous shrub which grows 8-15' tall. Deep purple to wine red, sweetly fragrant, single flowers with white edges. Excellent fresh cut flower.

Grown in plastic pots!

Willow, Dappled (*Salix integra*) \$4.00 ea.

Height and spread reach 3 to 5 feet. Its main attraction is the tri-color leaves of white, green and pink. We advise periodic trimming to maintain leaf variegation. Tolerates wet conditions. Leaf color stays better in full sun.

Rhododendron Dwarf PJM Lavender \$4.00 ea.

Height and spread 3 to 6 feet. A semi-dwarf rhododendron with small evergreen foliage. Small bright lavender pink flowers in early spring. Compact growth habit, will not get out of hand. Good for under low windows.

Blue Fescue Grass (*Festuca glauca* 'Elijah Blue') \$3.00 ea.

This is a clumping, evergreen, cool season grass. Elijah Blue is one of the best cultivars of Blue Fescue with soft, bright blue foliage. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. It does not do well in hot, humid areas. Good color accent for rock gardens or borders.

Purple Coneflower (*Echinacea purpurea*) \$3.00 ea.

A very robust perennial. This plant grows to a height of 24 to 36 inches tall with a spread of 12 to 18 inches. The large, daisy-like flowers grow on sturdy stems ranging in height from 3 to 5 feet. The flower petals range in color from purple to lavender. The seed center is a large, orange-copper colored cone that is hard and prickly. Blooms all summer and into autumn. Plant in full sun or partial shade. Prefers well drained fertile soil, but is drought tolerant and adaptable to heat, poor soils and high humidity. Maintenance free. Great for cutting and drying. A butterfly favorite. Goldfinches and other birds love to feast on the seeds in winter. One of the most dependable flowers lending color to a garden, in the height of the summer. Stunning in mass plantings!
