

# Memorial Tree Specifications



**Red Maple:** Will grow to over 25 feet tall, bright red leaves in autumn



**Sugar Maple:** Will grow to 50-70 feet, bright yellow, red, and orange leaves in the autumn



**Serviceberry:** Will grow 25-30 feet, White spring blooms, bright fall color, great refuge and food source for wildlife



**River Birch:** Will grow 40-60 feet tall, noted for unique, beautiful textured bark. Striking in the winter months.

# Memorial Tree Specifications



**Shrub dogwood/bailey red twig:** Will grow 8-10 feet, white flowers in spring, brilliant red branches in the fall, great wildlife refuge.



**Dogwood Tree:** Will grow 15-25 feet, striking white flowers in the spring, red foliage in the autumn, red fruits in the fall to attract wildlife



**Witch Hazel:** Will grow 15 – 20 feet, yellow flowers in the autumn, striking throughout the winter



**Tulip Poplar:** Will grow 80-120 feet, long straight trunk, bright green leaves the resemble tulip leaves, deep gold foliage in the autumn, gorgeous flowers in the spring

# Memorial Tree Specifications



**Sweetbay Magnolia:** Will grow 10-20 feet, sporting fragrant white flowers in the spring and glossy green leaves throughout the summer.



**Flowering Crabapple:** Will grow 16-18 feet, growing pink/red flowers all spring and purplish foliage throughout the summer. Offers fruit to wildlife all winter.



**Blackgum:** Will grow up to 95 feet, foliage becomes gold, scarlet, and purple throughout the autumn. Offers dark berries to wildlife all winter for a variety of species.



**Sourwood:** Will grow 25-30 feet. Beautiful fragrant white flowers in the late spring, yellow, red and purple foliage throughout the autumn. Great for pollination.

# Memorial Tree Specifications



**White Pine:** Will grow 50-80 feet. Sports soft, blue-green needles. Perfect for wind-breaks and borders.



**Swamp White Oak:** Will grow 50-60 feet. Beautiful hard deciduous, showy dark green leaves with complementary white coloring underneath. Gold foliage in the autumn.



**Pin Oak:** Will grow 60-70 feet. Leaves turn scarlet and gold in the autumn, acorns are a food source for a variety of wildlife species.



**Red Oak:** Will grow 60-75 feet. Brilliant red foliage in the autumn months.

# Memorial Tree Specifications



**Rosebay Rhododendron:** Will grow approximately 15 feet. It is an evergreen shrub that produces a showy curtain of bloom in late spring.



**Pussy Willow:** Will grow to 15-25 feet. Signature spring blooms, one of the first in the region. Key food source for wildlife and wonderful cover for them also.



**Canadian Hemlock:** Will grow to 60-70 feet. Creates dappled shade, perfect cover for a variety of wildlife species. Evergreen, showing its foliage year-round.



**Viburnum Arrowwood:** Will grow to 6-12 feet. Striking showy spring flowers, followed by lush summer foliage. Autumn fruit is a great source for birds; many butterflies and moths rely on foliage for food.
